When a Veteran Asks About the Toxic Exposure Screening

If yes: "You can call your nearest VA medical facility to ask about the screening or make an appointment. You can also request to be screened over the phone. Would you like help looking up the number?"

RESPONSE: "All Veterans enrolled in VA health care can now receive a toxic exposure screening at the nearest VA medical facility.

Are you enrolled in VA health care?"

If no: "You may be newly eligible under the PACT Act. Here are a couple options for how to apply:

When a Veteran Asks About the PACT Act or VA Benefits Eligibility

If yes: "A new law was recently passed to expand and extend VA health care and benefits. You may qualify for additional benefits."

ASK: Are you currently enrolled in VA health care, or do you receive any VA benefits?

Then, move to the next ASK.

If no: "A new law was recently passed to expand and extend VA health care and benefits to Veterans of the Vietnam, Gulf War, and Post-9/11 eras. Even if you didn't qualify for VA health care and benefits before, you may be eligible now. You can find more information on VA.gov/PACT."

ASK: Have you received your toxic exposure screening yet?

If yes: "Great. Please be sure to discuss any symptoms you think may be related to an exposure with your provider."

If no: "You can call your nearest VA medical facility to ask about the screening or make an appointment. You can also request to be screened over the phone. Would you like help looking up the number?"
